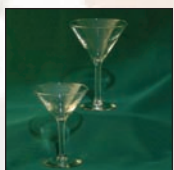
**High Ball** (10 oz) – For tall mixed drinks with ice. Can also be used for soft drinks.



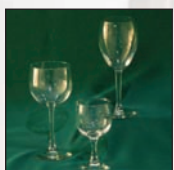
**Pilsner** (12 oz) – Most requested glass for serving beer and ale.

**Classic Martini** (6 oz & 10 oz) – Traditional stemmed glass for cocktails such as Martinis, Cosmopolitans, and Manhattans.



**Wine** (6 oz, 13 oz, & 13.5 oz balloon) – Versatile stemware used primarily for white and red wines. The 6 oz stem also appropriate for sweet wine, the 13 oz used for both red and white wines and the balloon goblet most appropriate for red wine and sangria.

## SPOOKY DONUT EYEBALLS

Delightful for any Halloween party – whether it's for children or adults, these novelty confections will be a sure hit.

- 👹 2 12-oz. bags white chocolate morsels
- 👹 4 teaspoons vegetable shortening
- 👹 Glazed donut holes (we used Entenmann's®)
- 👹 Round Gummi Savers® jellied candies
- 👹 M&M® chocolate candies
- 👹 Red food coloring



Melt white chocolate morsels with vegetable shortening in microwave oven or on the stove in a double boiler over simmering water stirring frequently until smooth.

Drop the donut holes into the melted chocolate, one at a time. Using a fork, coat the donut hole in chocolate. Lift and gently shake to remove excess chocolate. Place coated donut hole on a cookie sheet lined with wax paper. Repeat with remaining donut holes. Reserve unused chocolate. Place the Gummi Savers candy on the top surface of the donut holes. Place a small dab of the melted chocolate on the M & M's and stick them onto the jelled candies.

Refrigerate until set, about 10 minutes. With a toothpick, draw "veins" on the eyeballs with the red food color. Refrigerate until ready to serve.

(Note: in the Canton Chair Rental test kitchens we found the above quantity of chocolate covered at least 50 donut holes.)

## **Helpful Tips for Holiday Entertaining:**

- Y *Plan on approximately 2 drinks per person per hour. A 750ml bottle will yield 17 shots of liquor or 5 glasses of wine.*
- Y *When serving Champagne – one case of 12 fifths will serve 50 people*
- Y *Guests tend to mislay their glasses. So have plenty to spare. Allowing 4 to 5 drinking glasses per person is a good rule of thumb.*
- Y *You can never have too much ice. Allow at least 1 pound of ice per person.*
- Y *You will need three bottles of mix for every bottle of spirits*
- Y *One gallon of punch serves 24 people*
- Y *One pound of coffee will make 60 cups*
- Y *Always offer food when alcohol is served.*
- Y *Don't forget the napkins. Have plenty on hand.*
- Y *Have some nonalcoholic beverages available, including bottled water.*

## **Estimating Quantities of Hors d'oeuvres**

When estimating the number of hors d'oeuvres to serve at a party a good rule of thumb is to plan on 4 to 6 appetizers being consumed per person per hour at cocktail parties preceding a dinner. For parties where a dinner will not be served, plan on 8 to 10 appetizers per person for every 60 to 90 minutes of the party.

It's always wise to have some canned nuts, jars of pitted olives, and blocks of good cheese in the pantry in case the hors d'oeuvres start running low.
